1. Privacy Notice

Information we collect

We may collect personal information when you:

- subscribe to our prayer news or ministry updates;
- contact us through our website, by email or by telephone;
- make a donation;
- register for an event;
- request information about our work; or
- otherwise communicate with us.

The information we may collect includes:

- your name;
- postal address;
- email address;
- telephone number;
- donation information;
- Gift Aid declarations; and
- information relating to enquiries you make.

We do not store your full debit or credit card details.

How we use your information

We use your information to:

- provide information you have requested;
- communicate with you;
- distribute prayer news and ministry updates;
- administer donations;
- process Gift Aid claims;
- organise events;
- maintain accurate records;
- improve our website; and
- comply with legal obligations.

Legal basis for processing

Under UK data protection law, we process personal information using one or more of the following lawful bases:

Consent

For prayer news subscriptions and certain communications.

Contract

To fulfil requests you make.

Legal obligation

To meet our legal and financial responsibilities, including accounting and Gift Aid requirements.

Legitimate interests

To administer and develop the charitable work of Platform 67.

Prayer news and email communications

We use Mailchimp to distribute prayer news and ministry updates.

You can unsubscribe at any time by:

- clicking the unsubscribe link in any email; or
- contacting us directly.

Donations

Donations may be received through:

- PayPal;
- Stewardship; or
- bank transfer.

These organisations have their own privacy policies and we encourage you to review them before making a donation.

Sharing your information

We will never sell, rent or trade your personal information.

We may share information with trusted organisations that provide services on our behalf, such as:

- email distribution services;
- payment processing providers;
- website hosting providers; and
- IT support providers.

These organisations may only use your information to provide services for Platform 67.

How long we keep information

We only keep personal information for as long as necessary.

For example:

- prayer news subscriptions are retained until you unsubscribe;
- donation records are retained in accordance with legal and accounting requirements; and
- enquiries are retained only for as long as necessary to deal with your request.

Children

Platform 67 does not intentionally collect personal information from children under 18 years of age.

If we become aware that such information has been collected unintentionally, we will delete it promptly.

Your rights

Under UK data protection law, you have the right to:

- access your personal information;
- correct inaccurate information;
- request deletion of information;
- restrict how information is used;
- object to processing;
- request a copy of your information in a portable format; and
- withdraw consent where consent has been given.
